CONFESSION OF FAITH

The Belgic Confession of Faith 35 (part5)

The work Christ does in us through the Lord's Supper, being by the Spirit, is hidden and incomprehensible. Yet, we do not err when we say that what we eat and drink is His natural body and blood.¹ But the manner of our partaking is not by the mouth, but by the Spirit through faith. So, although Christ always sits at the right hand of His Father in the heavens,² He does not therefore cease to make us truly partakers of Himself through faith. This feast is a spiritual feast at which Christ communicates Himself to us with all His benefits and gives us Himself and all the merits of His suffering and death to enjoy.³ He nourishes, strengthens, and comforts our souls, which are otherwise destitute of all comfort, by the eating of His flesh, and He quickens and refreshes them by the drinking of His blood.⁴
