CONFESSION OF FAITH

Belgic Confession, Article 29 (part 1)

We believe that we ought to discern the true church diligently and carefully according to the Word of God, since all sects in the world claim for themselves the title “church.” We do not speak here of hypocrites in the church, who are not of the church, though they are physically present. We speak of distinguishing the body and fellowship of the true church from all sects that call themselves “the church.” The marks by which the true church can be recognized are: the pure preaching of the gospel, the pure administration of the sacraments as instituted by Christ, and the right use of church discipline to restrain sin.
