Abby: Please pray for continued healing from her stroke last year. Abby has been experiencing fatigue, migraines, passing out, word finding difficulties and slurred speech for the past couple of months. Please pray for her and Travis as they seek guidance from her doctors.

Karen: is battling primary peritoneal carcinoma. She and Dave met with the clinical trial oncologist that verified there is 'minimal to none' tumor progression. She indicated that while it is difficult to determine how effective the trial treatments are at this point, that is not unusual this early in the process. The fact that there is no growth is an encouragement. They are recommending that Karen continue with the trial. Karen will have another evaluation about the end of September. Karen was able to have her fourth transfusion. The side effects were as anticipated; more intense.
